

FULBRIGHT SCHOLAR-IN-RESIDENCE PROGRAM



Aims Community College in Greenley, Colorado Academic Year 2010/2011

The Fulbright Commission announces that one grant will be awarded to lecture in the United States during the 2010/11 academic year at Aims Community College. Applications will be accepted in the fields of **energy engineering, environmental studies, or sustainability studies**. The grant period is August 2010 until May 2011.

The academic goals for the Scholar are to teach at least one to two courses each semester in the wind and solar disciplines, and to contribute his/her expertise to further development of the energy/sustainability curriculum. Additionally, a strong collaboration exists with the University of Northern Colorado, which is also beginning to develop a sustainability and alternative energy curriculum. This partnership would foster sharing the expertise of the scholar and could lead to lectures, presentations, and course work to benefit both schools.

The primary objective of the Scholar-in-Residence program is to bring scholars and professionals from abroad to campuses that do not often host visiting scholars, particularly to institutions that serve minority populations or students underrepresented in international programs.

ELIGIBILITY:

- At least a Masters degree or equivalent professional training or experience
- Expertise and teaching experience in sustainable energy fields and related course curricula
- Fluent in oral and written English
- Swedish citizenship

Persons having dual citizenship with the United States or desiring or holding permanent residence in the United States are not eligible for Fulbright awards. Scholars selected under the Fulbright Program will be issued visa documents under the Fulbright visa program number and must use those documents.

FINANCIAL BENEFITS:

- Maintenance allowance of \$29,600 USD
- Round-trip travel between Sweden and the United States
- Dependents' allowances (with special conditions)
- Salary supplement of \$4,000 from Aims Community College
- Accident and sickness medical coverage
